## STUDENT MOBILITY – PhD Program

Each mobility agreement will be customized depending on its area of research and its specific needs. The mobility is agreed upon between schools after analyzing the candidate's profile.

For the students to apply for additional funding for a research stay abroad:

- The research stay must be clearly relevant to the dissertation. The student will prepare a short document explaining the connection between her/his stay and her/his PhD project/dissertation, including specific agreements with the faculty members of the host institution.
- The student must have the approval from the Advisor.
- The student must have an official invitation letter from the institution where she/he wishes to do the stay.
- The student must be in good academic standing (as determined by students' academic records) The funding will cover one round-trip (even if the student spends her stay abroad at several institutions) as well as possible enrollment / visiting fees. Additional funding will be decided on a case-by-case basis.
